Article IV

Relations Among the States

Section 1 Recognize each others acts

- **Each state must accept the laws of other states**
- **Respect each others records and court decisions**

Section 2 Citizen rights in other states

- **In another state you have rights of those citizens**
- **Can be extradited for crimes**
- **13 amendment changed**

Slaves and indentured servants could not escape to another state

Section 3 New States

- **Congress admits**
- **Congress gives or sells public land**

Section 4 republican Gov.

- **Every state guaranteed republican form of government**

Article V

Amending the Constitution

Art 5

Propose change

- **2 / 3 both houses of congress**
- **2 / 3 states ask for convention**

Ratify change

- **3 / 4 State governments**
- **3 / 4 States in convention**

Article VI

National Supremacy

Art VI

- **All debts and treaties made by congress are binding**
- **Constitution is highest law of the land**
- **Federal and State officials must support constitution**

Article VII

Ratification

When 9 states ratify the constitution it is the law of the land.
